Student Accidents and Injuries

It is a natural part of growing up that children occasionally get hurt. Cuts, scrapes, bruises, even broken bones can happen. At Wildwood School, we know these everyday occurrences can be a bit more challenging and concerning. The health office will collaborate with teachers to ensure any visible or potential injury is reported to families in a timely manner.

The health office is responsible for providing first aid to all students.

Staff members who witnessed the injury complete a student injury form that is kept on file in the health office.

A member of the health office will contact the student's family by the end of the school day. For minor injuries or potential injuries, ParentSquare or email may be used. For more complex or concerning injuries, a phone call will be made.

If a child has been injured, either in school or outside of a school, a return to school note from a physician's office may be required. In addition, related services such as PT and OT may need a return to service note in order to restart therapy.
